MANURE MANAGEMENT AND DISPOSAL ORDINANCE

COMPLIANCE

The “Manure Management and Disposal” Ordinance became effective on July 1, 2008. This Ordinance requires pick up of manure from any type of farm animal kept or raised for use or pleasure. If you are not already doing so, please comply with this Ordinance through the following actions:

- **Pick up** your animal manure regularly;
- **Store** the manure correctly either in an approved container with a lid or in a structure approved by the Public Works Department; and
- **Remove** the manure from your property at least once a week through Waste Management or by obtaining a “self haul” permit from the Public Works Department. (To sign up for the Waste Management manure collection service, call (951) 270-5656.)

Note: Due to State water quality control laws, spreading, disking or stockpiling of manure on private properties is prohibited.

Fines for non-compliance with this Ordinance are \$100 for the first violation, \$200 for the second violation, and \$500 for additional violations. More stringent fines can also be levied by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board.
